Junior League of Champaign-Urbana has a new program underway! The ***Save the Music/Music for All*** program puts instruments into the hands of local public school students who want to play and study music but do not have the family funds to do so. Working with the Music Shoppe, JLCU is sponsoring a music instrument drive!

The *Save the Music/Music for All* program is part of the JLCU League Locker program. In partnership with Rogards Office Plus and the Music Shoppe, over \$36,000 will be used to purchase and distribute school supplies to children in need at Champaign and Urbana public schools and Circle Academy within Cunningham Children's Home. This project also helps fund field trips, physical education projects, art projects and the 36 music scholarships.
